











Shangri-La's Accessible Spring Festival, held the Saturday before Easter, is a drive-thru, activity-based experience for individuals with disabilities of all ages. An alternative to the traditional egg hunt experience, attendees participate in spring-themed activities and games through their vehicle's window. This year's event aims to serve 150 cars or approximately 300 people.

BECOME AN ACCESSIBLE SPRING FESTIVAL SIDEKICK

This year, Shangri-La is welcoming up to 6 sidekicks to the Accessible Spring Festival. Sidekicks are organizations or businesses that provide programming, supports, or resources to people with disabilities and/or have a desire to connect with the disability community.

As a sidekick,

- You'll get a 10x10 booth space along the Accessible Spring Festival route.
 These booth spaces are free to sidekicks. Shangri-La will provide one 6 ft table and two chairs. You'll need to provide your own 10x10 pop-up tent.
- You'll need to offer some sort of game, activity, demonstration, or giveaway
 at your booth. (Games and activities must be able to be done through a car
 window or car door. Sidekicks should plan for 300 giveaways. Need help
 with an idea? Let us know. We can brainstorm!)
- You are welcome to handout information about your programs, services, or supports to each car.

at Shangri-La's Salem Office (4080 Reed Road SE #150) The event is from 10 a.m. - 1 p.m. Sidekicks will set-up the morning of the event between 8 a.m. - 9:30 a.m.
